October: Echinocactus II Group

(subfamily Cactoideae, tribe Echinocacteae)
Echinocactus, Ferocactus, Leuchtenbergia, Stenocactus (Echinofossulocactus),
Ariocarpus, Obregonia, Aztekium

November: Epiphytic Group

(subfamily Cactoideae, tribes Hylocereeae, Rhipsalideae)
Pereskia, Maihuenia, Pereskiaopsis, Opuntia, Cereus, Carnegiea, Cephalocereus,
