


Join us as we welcome the infamous Fred Katterman from the Connecticut Cactus & Succulent Society as he brings us on his journey to Peru many years ago ..





The C&S Garden at the Wilbur D. May Arboretum, in Reno, Nevada by Rod Dimmitt


This program features the design for a new 2.5-acre Cactus and Succulent Garden for the Wilbur D. May Arboretum & Botanical Garden in Reno, Nevada. This garden will showcase low water-use plants in a landscape setting and be a demonstration garden for our high desert community. The Arboretum is located in the Washoe County Rancho San Rafael Regional Park complex.

Rod Dimmitt will share the process that they used that focuses on what their community would like to see in a new garden at the Arboretum. They are working with the Didier Design Studio on the design and bid package for this new garden, in conjunction with Washoe County, that will be the first new garden in the Arboretum since the mid-1990's. The May Arboretum is 13 acres developed with 10 acres still to go.

About Rod Dimmitt - Rod has been a Cactus and Succulent fan for over 40 years. When he and his wife moved to Carson City, Nevada, from Reno 17 years ago, Rod wanted to landscape his front yard in nothing but cactus, yuccas, agaves, among other cold hardy succulents. Living in the driest state in the Union, averaging only 7 inches of precipitation annually, and with cold temperatures that routinely dip into the upper teens and lower 20's at night during the Winter, the challenge was plant selection. Rod has been working with the staff at the Wilbur D. May Arboretum & Botanical Garden, along with the May Arboretum Society, the non-profit that supports the Arboretum, to develop a Cactus and Succulent Garden that will feature plants found all around the world.
